When is the Fast-A-Thon?

Starts: 6:15 pm in St. Stanislaus School gym on Holy Thursday, March 29 Ends: 9:15 am in St. Stanislaus Kostka Church on Good Friday, March 30

What Happens at the Fast-A-Thon?

You are to arrive in the Gym one hour (at 6:15 pm) prior to the start of the 7:15 pm Holy Thursday, March 29 Mass in St. Stanislaus Kostka Church. Your sleeping gear will be placed on the St. Stan's gym stage and your Pledge Sheets and Money Donations will be collected before Mass. We attend the 7:15 pm Mass as a Group.
