

Our Goal is Continuous Prayer for Vocations


Invisible Monastery is a free web site that helps organize prayer for vocations. Our goal is to attract enough members to pray for vocations 24 hours a day in every diocese.


Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world, *have mercy on us*.
