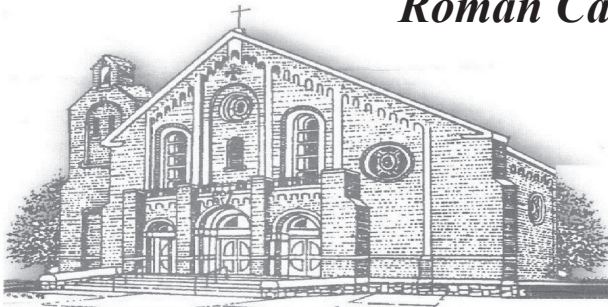

The Bible tells us that during his family's trip to Jerusalem, Jesus went missing for three days before being found in the Temple. Why did he stay behind? What did he do? Who

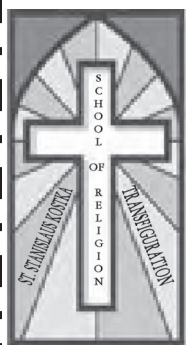
did he meet? Where did he sleep? Was he ever in danger?

ARE YOU "SURE" THAT YOU ARE A REGISTERED PARISHIONER?

While we are always so glad to meet people and friends at Transfiguration and St. Stanislaus Kostka who attend Mass or Parish events or whose child is registered in our Academy or School of Religion...this does not mean you are automatically a parishioner.

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Membership requires simply signing up and formally enrolling yourself in the parish. But it is also more than just filling out a form. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many Masses, programs and events are planned and scheduled.

Registration not only shows that you belong, but may be necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, participating in religious education programs and getting donation statements for tax purposes.

If you are not sure if you are a registered parishioner, just call our Rectory and we will confirm if you are, and if you are not, we will gladly register you over the phone or you can complete a the form found on our website (select Important Forms under the Our Parish- tab).

Si bien, siempre estamos encantados de conocer a personas y amigos en Transfiguration y St. Stanislaus Kostka que asisten a los eventos de la misa o parroquiales o cuyo niño está registrado en nuestra Academia o Escuela de Religión ... esto no significa que usted sea automáticamente un feligrés.

La inscripción es la forma oficial en que nos unimos a una comunidad parroquial. La afiliación requiere simplemente registrarse e inscribirse formalmente en la parroquia.
