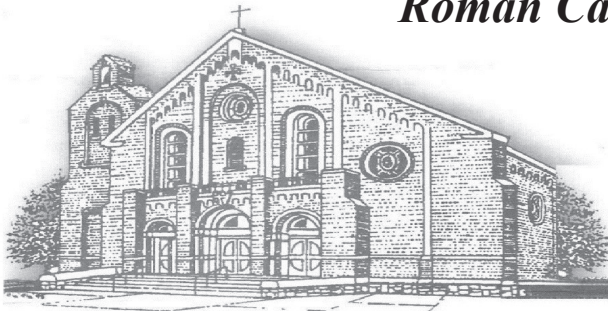

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT



The **Feast of the Annunciation** refers to the day the Angel Gabriel visited the Virgin Mary and “announced” that she was chosen from all women to be the Mother of Jesus. Her simple, “Yes,” to the angel’s announcement led to the birth of Christ and the world has never been the same. We celebrate that Feast tomorrow which stands as a reminder that all of us, in imitation of Mary, are asked daily to offer our “Yes” to Jesus.
